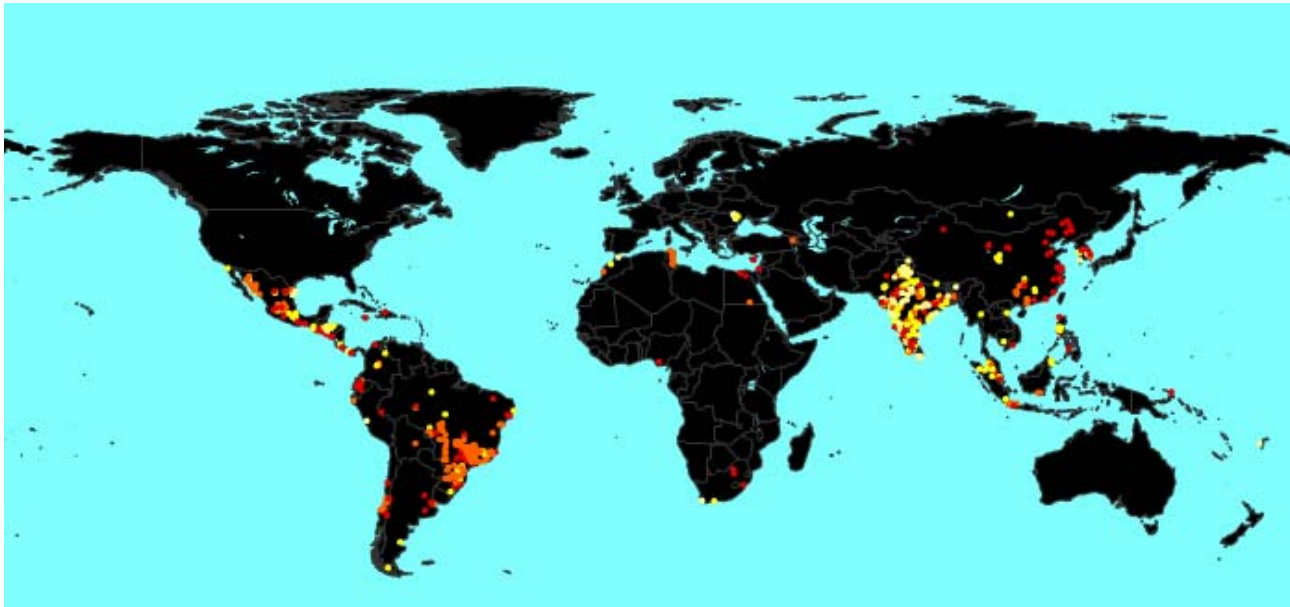

Measuring success

To date: **765 registered CDM projects**
1.02 billion CERs expected to the end of 2012

In pipeline: **> 2,100 projects**
> 2.2 billion CERs expected to the end of 2012



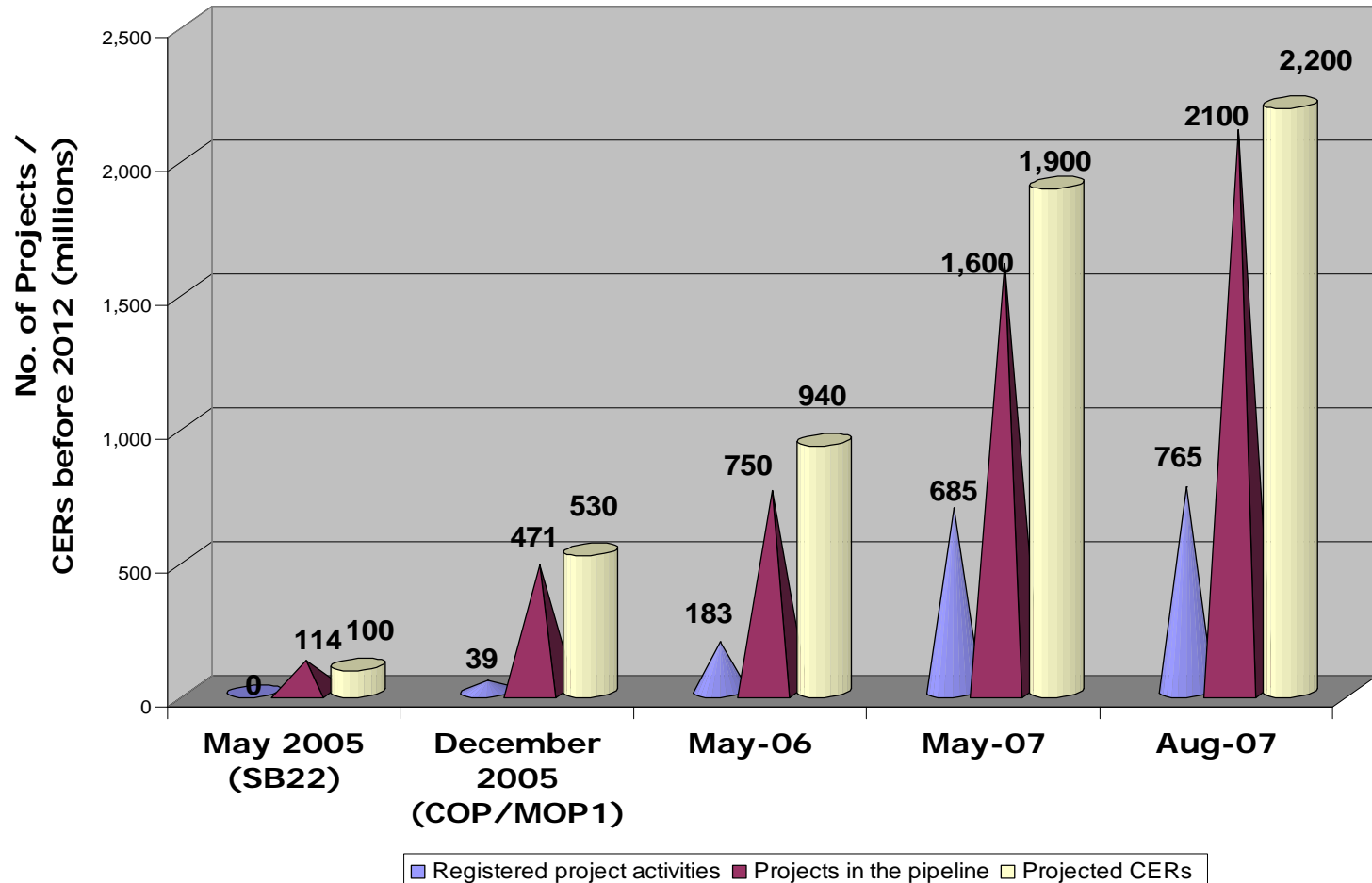

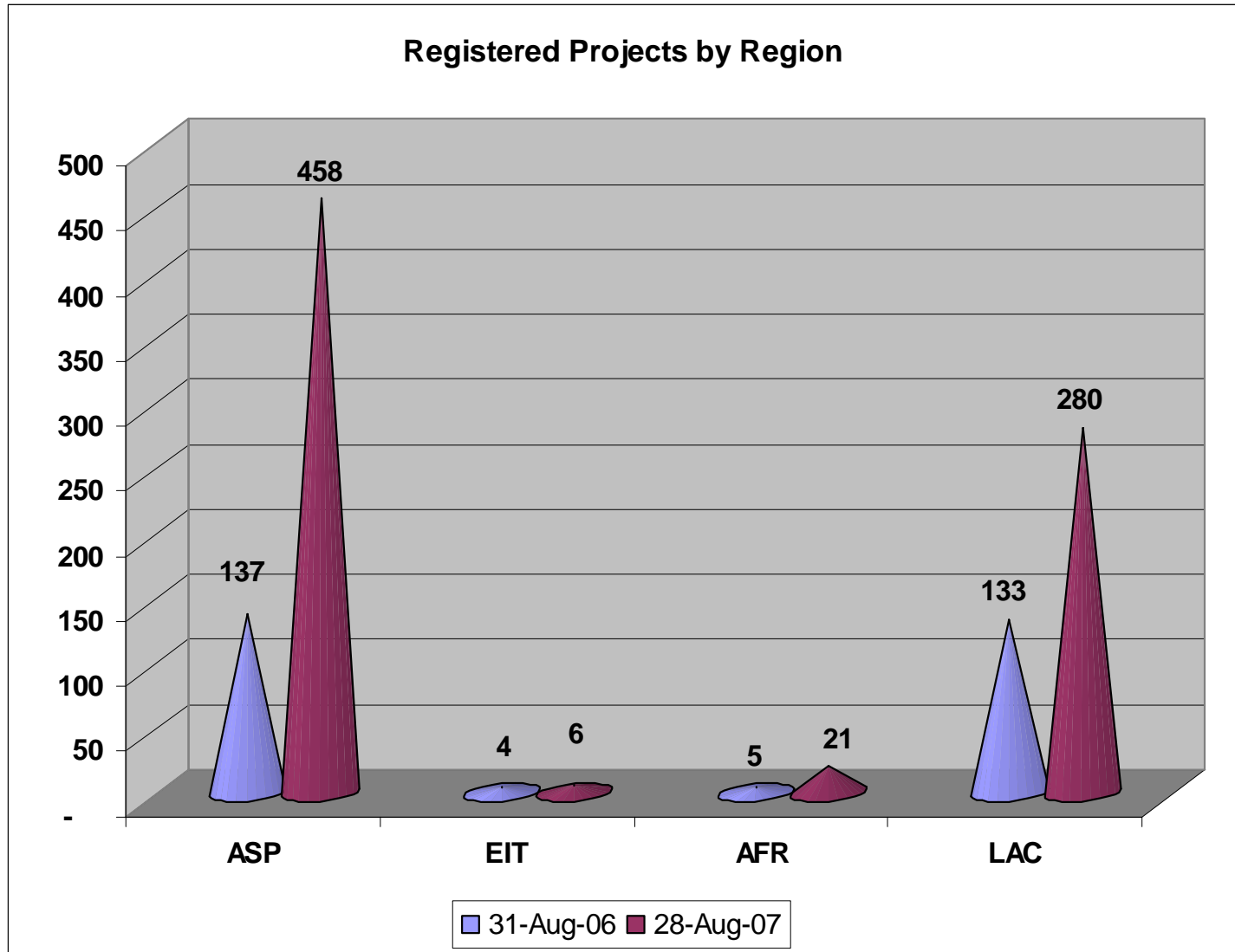

Status of the CDM | LAC – projects

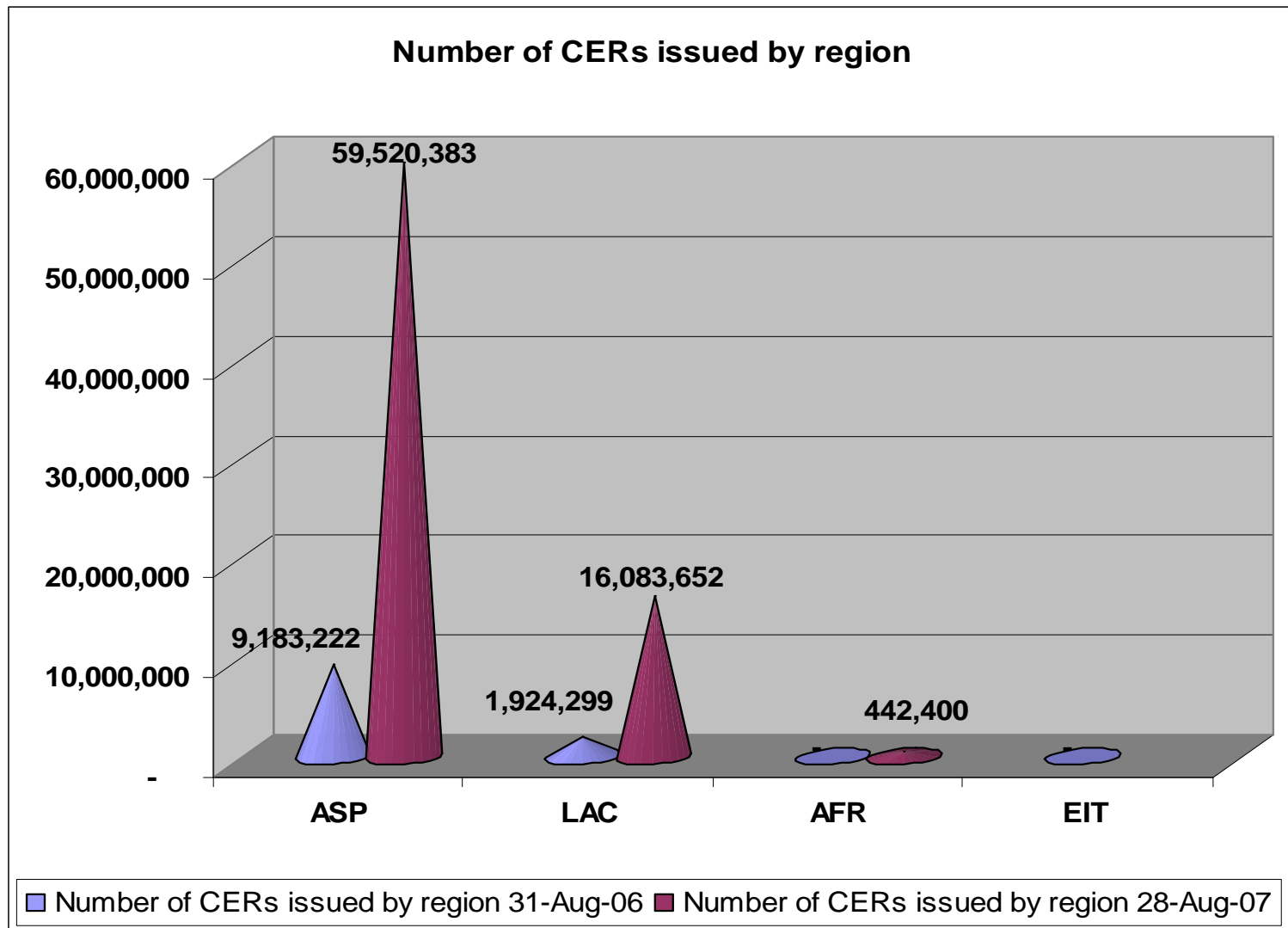


Status of the CDM | LAC – by Country

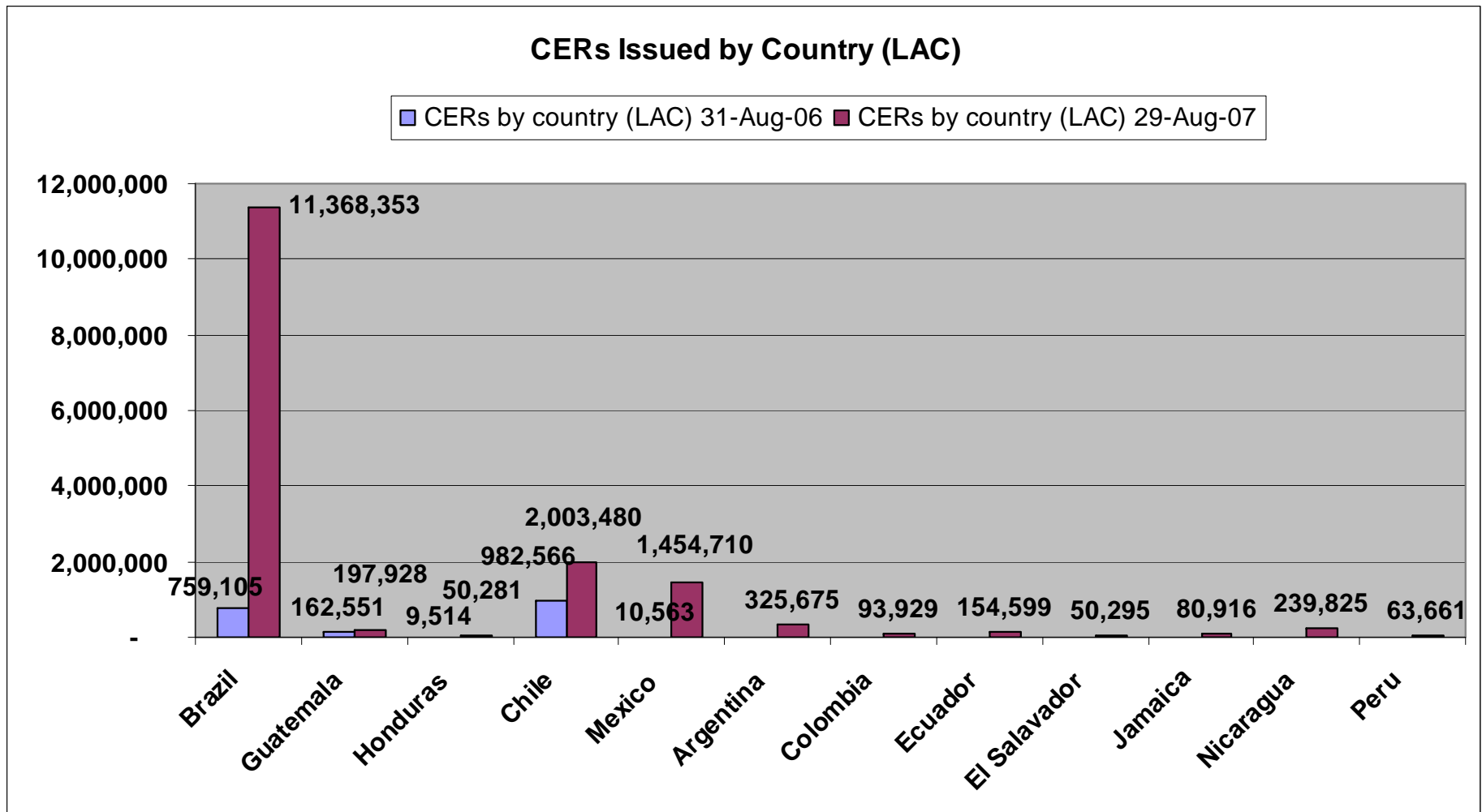

Status of the CDM | LAC – CERs



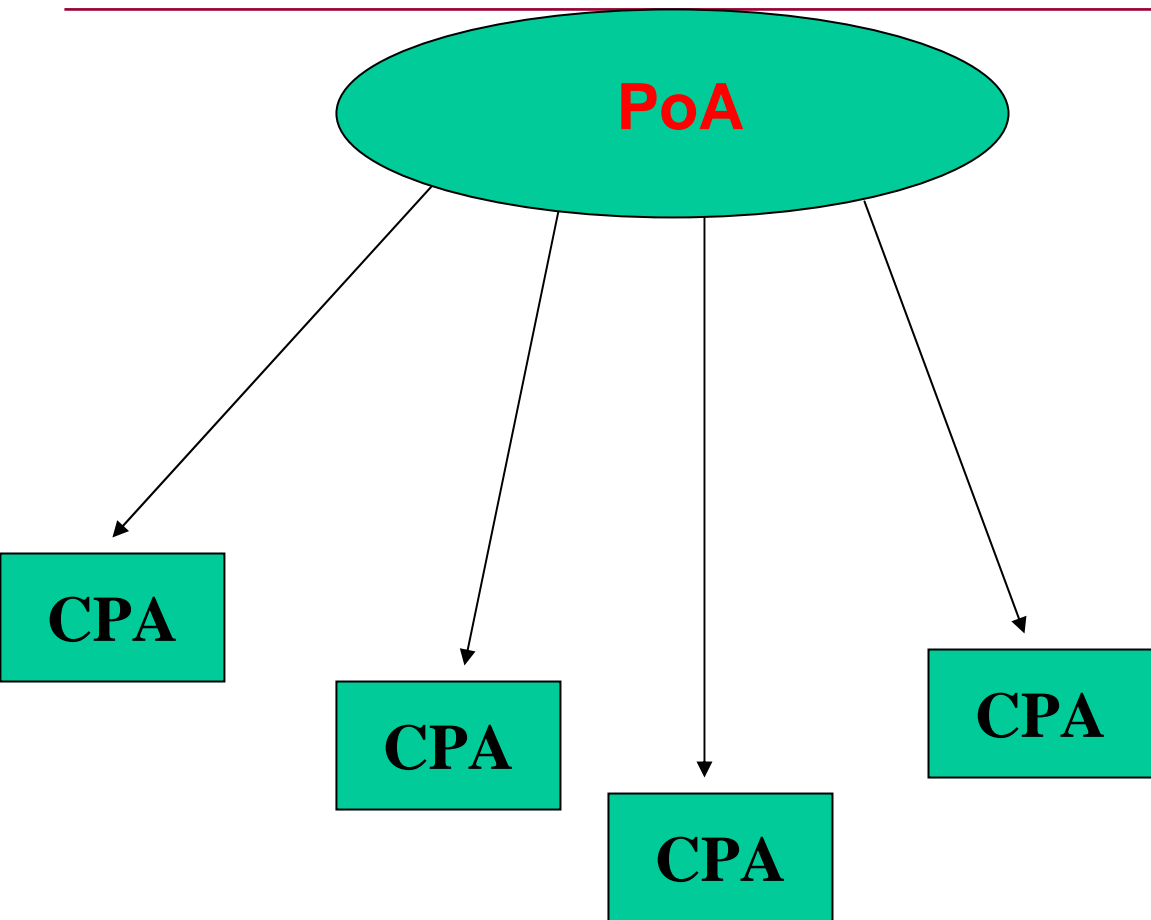
- Processes / Procedures – defined / open to optimisation
- Methodology standard:
 - Number increasing / consolidation / generic tools
 - Process being optimised and shortened
- Registration:
 - 765 registered projects
 - 26 rejected (around 3.3%)
- “Central bank”:
 - 76 million CERs for 334 requests
 - 2 rejected (less than 0.8%)
- Accreditation body: Opportunity for single accreditation recognized in all Parties to KP.



CDM works, now let's focus on:

- Continuously increasing its **efficiency**:
 - Further information access, e.g. CDM Bazaar
 - Further access to decisions, e.g. catalogue of decisions
 - Further interaction with “players” , e.g. fora (DOE, DNA), project participants
- Realizing its **potential** (scaling up)
 - Programme of activities (POA)
 - Sectors: energy efficiency / transport
 - Methodologies: simplicity, applicability
 - Regional opportunities
- Regulatory optimization : relatively slim / streamlining and optimization opportunities have and will be pursued
- EB to report to CMP3 its ability to deal with its “success”





- Voluntary coordinated action by a private or public entity implementing any policy/measure or stated goal

- PoA constitutes of individual CDM project activities (CPAs), with no limits on CPAs under a PoA.

Action of PoA leads to GHG emission reductions or increase net GHG removals by sinks that are additional to any that would occur in the absence of the PoA,

- **Can extend to one or more countries**
 - Letter of approval from each host country and AI country
 - Letter of approval states a PoA and, hence, each CPA under it contributes to SD of host country

- **CPA are similar project activities that**
 - Apply the same approved baseline and monitoring methodology,
 - Involving one type of technology or set of interrelated measures in the same type of facility/installation/land.

- **Duration of 28 years**
 - Renewed every 7 years as per “Procedure for renewal of crediting period of registered CDM project activity”

➤ **Procedures:**

- Procedures for registration of a programme of activities as a single CDM project activity and issuance of certified emission reductions for a programme of activities (Annex 39, EB32)

➤ **Guidance clarifications:**

- Eligibility of activities under the CDM (EB 33, para 30)
- Guidance on the registration of a programme of activities as a single project activity (Annex 38, EB32)
- Guidance for determining the occurrence of de-bundling under a programme of activities (PoA) (Annex 21, EB33)

➤ **Forms available for POA:**

- CDM Programme of Activities Design Document form (PoA-DD)
- CDM Programme Activity Design Document form (PoA-CPA-DD)
- Small-Scale CDM Programme of Activities Design Document form (SSC-PoA-DD)
- Small-Scale CDM Programme Activity Design Document form (PoA-SSC-CPA-DD)

Validation to be starting by September 2007

➤ **EB requested secretariat to work on EE**

➤ **In response the secretariat:**

- Conducted an assessment of the status of EE meths & requirements to further this area as a priority drawing also on external expertise
- EB noted the lack of demand-side EE methods available, while supply-side is well represented
- Interacts with external agencies/orgs in networking & providing inputs to the development of methodologies
- Undertakes work to assist in the development of a demand side EE consolidated methodology
- Updates the EB and public on progress on this matter at every meeting

- A set of criteria used for marking EB decisions has been developed
- All EB reports have been marked and a test version of the catalogue is available to public to use and comment on its functionality and usefulness – ensure that users have useful tool
- Develop a system that integrates the drafting of EB agenda, annotations report.
- Open search facility on all text

(jointly implemented with UNEP RISOE):
 - Launched today
 - Is to do what its name indicates – provide a market where people meet info is exchanged - at low cost (free, internet based)
 - Have project developers indicate in this virtual space what their ideas proposals are
 - Have service companies (expert, brokers, information platforms, other market platforms) make their services known
 - Have buyers, investors indicate their interest to buy/invest
 - YOUR tool – register – use it – provide feedback what features or changes would make it more useful to you.
